

- · Mar- Alzheimer's Pancake Breakfast- \$907 donation to benefit Alzheimer's Association of Iowa City
- Mar- Donated chef-prepared pastries and coffee to the Coralville Fire Depts- delivered by our Village Residents
- Apr- Good Friday Fish Fry & "The Old Man Band" donations for Alzheimer's raised \$265 for Alzheimer's Association of Iowa City
- Apr- Donated chef-prepared pastries and coffee to the Coralville Police Dept- delivered by our Village Residents
- May- Hosted a Chef-prepared Lunch for ROTC with 20 of our veterans- hosted 10 Cadre and Cadets
- June- Food Drive- Donated 115 pounds of non-perishable foods to the HACAP Food Reservoir, which
 provides food to families of children who use the food backpack program
- June- Donated \$300 to Classy Chassis Car Club for their car show- this donation goes to Iowa City Hospice
- July- Donated \$200 to the University of Iowa Saxophone program for their performance
- Aug- School backpack drive- donated supplies to fill 10 backpacks for Kirkwood Elementary School and \$70 in cash donations
- Aug- American Red Cross Blood Drive- donated 31 pints of blood
- Aug- donated 180 baby hats to the University of Iowa for newborns (so far this year)
- Sept- Donated \$150 for a presentation from the RARE Group- dedicated to the rescue, rehabilitation, and conservation of birds of prey throughout Iowa.
- Oct- Donated \$150 for Wildthunder Wild Animal Rescue and Rehabilitation presentation
- Oct- made bracelets for Breast Cancer Awareness- raised \$170 for University of Iowa Cancer Center


DON BUFFINGTON PRESENTS HIS SILVERPOINT DRAWINGS OF NATIVE AMERICANS
